

Lithuania, officially the **Republic of Lithuania** (Lithuanian: *Lietuvos Respublika*), is a country in Northern Europe. One of the three Baltic states, it is situated along the southeastern shore of the Baltic Sea, to the east of Sweden and Denmark. It is bordered by Latvia to the north, Belarus to the east and south, Poland to the south, and Kaliningrad Oblast (a Russian exclave) to the southwest. Lithuania is a member of the European Union, the Council of Europe, a full member of the Schengen Agreement and NATO. On 1 January 2015, Lithuania adopted the euro as the official currency and became the 19th member of the Eurozone.

Population and Religion

Lithuanians are one of the ethnic groups in the Baltic region. Lithuania has a population of about 2 944 459 people. According to the data from Eurostat, 66.1 per cent of the population of Lithuania, aged 25 – 64, can speak two or more foreign languages, 31.5 per cent can speak one foreign language, and a mere 2.5 percent of the population cannot speak any foreign languages. The foreign languages people speak the most are English and Russian. Lithuanians are sometimes called the northern Italians, referring to our warm sensual nature.

Lithuania became Christianised at the end of the 14th - beginning of the 15th century. Up until that time it was a pagan country. Today, Roman Catholics represent the majority of the population. The Russian Orthodox Church, Protestants-Lutherans, Evangelical Christians Baptists, Islamic and Judaic religions are all represented in Lithuania. Believers of all religions are equal before the law.

Climate

The climate of the Lithuania can be described as typical European continental influenced climate with warm, dry summers and fairly severe winters. January is the coldest month with daytime temperatures usually around -5°C, but in some cases winter months can be quite colder with temperatures far below zero, about -20°C or lower and strong, cold north-easterly winds. Heavy snowfall or even snowstorms are also possible on some days. The weather is often breezy and humid due to the proximity of the Baltic Sea.

In summer daytime temperatures reach 20-25°C, but sometimes quite higher, 30°C or more. In most of the time it is dry weather with sunny spells, rain often falls with sometimes heavy Thunderstorms that can occur at the end of the day. July is the warmest month with an average Temperature of 18°C. Annual Precipitation is about 400-600 mm.

Generally, the weather is best May-September, when days are warm and the nights are cool, although it rains more in spring than in summer. Autumn and winter are usually a little chilly and wet, sometimes snowy and often foggy.

Language

The Lithuanian language (*lietuvių kalba*) is the official state language of Lithuania and is recognized as one of the official languages of the European Union. There are about 2.96 million native Lithuanian speakers in Lithuania and about 0.2 million abroad.

Lithuanian is a Baltic language, closely related to Latvian, although they are not mutually intelligible. It is written in an adapted version of the Roman script. Lithuanian is believed to be the

linguistically most conservative living Indo-European tongue, retaining many features of Proto Indo-European. The only remaining live languages belonging to the Indo-European family of languages are Lithuanian and Latvian.

Utena is a capital of Eastern Aukštaitija and one of the oldest towns of Lithuania that was mentioned for first time in a letter of the King Mindaugas in 1261. For the 750th anniversary of the town a unique attraction – shining and playing fountain with water screen - was equipped in Lake Dauniškis. The lake reflects a snow white chapel of Mary Queen of Martyrs.

Utena Municipality is situated in the North East of Lithuania, 97km north of the capital Vilnius. Utena is within one hour of the Via Baltica highway, which connects Eastern Europe with Western Europe and Scandinavia.

A blue coat of arms reflects a shining golden horseshoe with golden sparks and symbolizes happiness and protects well-being of the house against the devil eye.



There are 28 educational institutions, including Utenos kolegija, the Regional Centre of the Vocational Education Children can get their education in Art, Music and Sports schools. One of the newest schools is gymnasium, named after the famous historian Adolfas Šapoka.



The city has two lakes Dauniškis and Vyžuonaitis. They are hosting the most beautiful parks in the city: Dauniškis park – the place of recreation and entertainment, Vyžuonaitis park - a future port of peace and walks are developed. City garden, Krašuona river-walks in downtown, Vyžuona Park bring joy to the eyes and the hearts of Utena residents and guests. The bike enthusiasts are not forgotten: there are many bike paths, old

streets are reconstructed and new built installing the bicycle lanes. <http://utenainfo.lt/en>

The present structure of the town creates perfect conditions for industry development and for the growth of new living districts, such as Vyturiai, Dauniškis, Ažuolija, Aukštakalnis, Krašuona.

The growth of Utena was encouraged by industrial development. Company AB “Utenos trikotažas” which made its first clothing in 1967, today is the most modern textile companies in Central and Easter Europe. The company production is sold to large retail chains and reaches end users in more than 50 countries. “Utena” brewery prides itself preserving excellence and brewing traditions inherited from the Czech for over nearly four decades of uninterrupted activity. UAB “Utenos mėsa” is one of the largest Lithuanian meat processing company with deep traditions. In 1997 a new dairy in Utena was built. Now it is named “UAB Rokiškio pienas” and it is famous for its honourable history as well as modern technologies, has received awards in national and international exhibitions.

ECTS credit allocation policy (institutional credit framework)

What is ECTS?

ECTS is a learner-centred system for credit accumulation and transfer, based on the principle of transparency of the learning, teaching and assessment processes. Its objective is to facilitate the planning, delivery and evaluation of study programmes and student mobility by recognising learning achievements and qualifications and periods of learning.




The ECTS credits

ECTS credits express the volume of learning based on the defined learning outcomes and their associated workload. 60 ECTS credits are allocated to the learning outcomes and associated workload of a full-time academic year or its equivalent, which normally comprises a number of educational components to which credits (on the basis of the learning outcomes and workload) are allocated. ECTS credits are generally expressed in whole numbers.

Application procedure for Erasmus+ students

-  1. **Erasmus + Student Application Form.** The application forms should be filled in electronically, printed out, signed and send per e-mail to the INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS DEPARTMENT, e-mail trs@utenos-kolegija.lt. There is no need to send the paper versions by post. You can just take the required signatures and stamps and send the scanned document to us. Kindly ask your Erasmus+ coordinator to send your nomination letter to trs@utenos-kolegija.lt.
-  2. **Learning agreement.** Learning Agreement has to be filled in, stamped and signed by the university and the student applying for the mobility. Both the learning agreement for studies and learning agreement for traineeship need to be filled in electronically. There is no need to send the agreements on paper by post. You can just take the required signatures and stamps and send the scanned document to us.
3. **Transcript of records.** Issued by sending institution and provides up-to-date record of students' progress in their studies: the educational components they have taken, the number of ECTS credits they have achieved and the grades they have been awarded.
4. **Passport or ID copy** (from both sides)
5. **Health insurance card or any other relevant document.** We recommend you to have travel insurance. European Health Insurance Card is obligatory! In case you cannot apply for a European Health Insurance Card, it is obligatory to have health insurance coverage in Lithuania. NB! Utena University of Applied Sciences does not provide you with neither accident insurance, health insurance or the liability insurance. Having the adequate insurance is the student's responsibility.
6. **2 official passport photos**
-  7. **Application for accommodation**
 - *The document package should be complete. Erasmus + students' applications can only be accepted from students of our partner institutions.*
 - **Deadline: 30 June (fall semester or full academic year); 10 December (spring semester).**

Language

The language of instruction for Erasmus+ exchange students is English. Please note that your language proficiency in English should be at least on the level B1/B2 in order to study or have a practical training at Utena University of Applied Sciences.

Practical information for incoming mobile students

BEFORE ARRIVAL

A citizen of a European Union Member State may enter the Republic of Lithuania and stay there in for a period not exceeding three months starting from the first day of entry into the Republic of Lithuania.

Family members of the citizens of a European Union Member State may enter the Republic of Lithuania together with the citizen of the European Union Member State or arrive to him/her and stay in the Republic of Lithuania for a period not exceeding three months starting from the first day of entry into the Republic of Lithuania.

An alien who is not a citizen of a European Union Member State and wants to enter the Republic of Lithuania and stay in it, must own a visa.

ARRIVAL

Travelling by plane. There are international airports in Vilnius, Kaunas and Palanga. They offer a wide range of flights and are expanding their destinations every year. There are buses that constantly commute between the airports (including Riga airport).

Travelling by train. The railway system in Lithuania belongs to the company Lietuvos Geležinkeliai (Lithuanian Railways). You can enter the country on international routes from Moscow, Minsk, Mahilyow, Warsaw and Saint Petersburg. Trains also run from Königsberg through Lithuania to some cities in Russia and Ukraine.

Travelling by bus is slow but comfortable. You can travel to Lithuania by bus from almost any European country. You can buy a ticket via the internet or at an international ticket office. Although the trip is longer, bus travel has its advantages; you can enjoy wonderful views through the window and there is virtually no limit on luggage weight.

If you've come from one of the 28 Member States of the European Union, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway or Switzerland and have a European card of health insurance, you are guaranteed state health care services in the case of an accident. You need to be aware that the card does not cover the expenses of health care services provided by the private sector.

If you are a citizen of a country outside the EU, you should contact the embassy of your country in Lithuania and enquire about the opportunities of health insurance in this country. Students above the age of 18 could be considered for insurance and get free medical care. To do so, they must present a document, proving their status as a student, to the territorial health insurance fund. Then, if you want to get registered at a health centre, you will have to fill in an application on a special form at the reception desk and present a document proving personal identity (with the photo and a National Identification Number).



Important! In the case of an accident or real threat to your health or property, immediately call the Single Emergency Call Number 112.

Accommodation/housing

Due to the increasing number of students, only places in shared rooms are offered. Rooms are shared by two or three students. Monthly rent of a place in a room in the "Student house" is 55 EUR. Rental fee is subject to change. International exchange students are required to pay for the accommodation in advance for the entire semester at their arrival or during the introductory week.

All the rooms have free access to Internet. Bathroom facilities are mostly shared by two rooms. There is one common use kitchen. Students are obliged to clean up and keep the order in the kitchen and rooms by themselves. Laundry room is also available for international students without extra charge.

For Erasmus + exchange Students the reservation of a place at the "Student house" is made through the International Relations Department. Students have to fill in Accommodation application form.

International degree-seeking students, apply for a place at the "Student house" by filling a relevant part of the Application form.

At the arrival, international students who were allocated a place at the "Student house" must sign an Agreement on Accommodation in Student House.

Students are responsible for any damage done while living in the "Student House".
